The Apple App Store provides anonymised metrics to allow the monitoring of the service. I do not share this information with the exception of providing summarised sales figures.

Information Collection and Use

PointPlot is an app which has the entire purpose of recording your location and other locations that you mark. This information does not leave the device with the exception of device backups. It is possible to export the data recorded in a variety of file formats, however this can only occur with the express intent of the user.

Log Data

The Apple App Store records and provides anonymised and sanitized metrics surrounding its use. There is also the opt in reporting of errors, which is a global setting on the device and not part of PointPlot.
